COURSE VENUE

The course will take place at HOSPITAL VETERINÁRIO CONSANIVET (https://veterinaria-sp.com.br/), located right in front of São Paulo-Morumbi Metro Station (Yellow Line 4) LINHA 4 AMARELA DO METRÔ.

GETTING TO SÃO PAULO

AIRPORTS:

Guarulhos (GRU): Main international airport with worldwide connections.

Congonhas (CGH): Best for domestic flights, closer to the venue.

WHERE TO STAY

We highly recommend booking your hotel in advance and choosing accommodation close to Yellow Metro Line 4 for maximum convenience.
